






MSG Leaders and other MSG representatives to include in all their statements at the UN and elsewhere their support for the FLNKS case and for the proper implementation of the provisions of the Noumea Accord, and to be alert to any move to delisting New Caledonia from the UN decolonization list;
- ii. MSG Leaders to consider the appropriate forms of assistance to the FLNKS leading up to the elections and can include: financial assistance, attachment of personnel to the FLNKS Bureau for capacity building, provision of observers during the elections, and other technical assistance.




