legislation. It is therefore a solid foundation on which we can build to ensure the coherence of the existing legal framework.

In this sense, we feel it is important not to revise the elements of the chapeau. Indeed, the condition that an attack must be "widespread" or "systematic" is disjunctive, not conjunctive. Either condition can be met. We believe it is important to maintain this in a future convention.

Furthermore, Switzerland also appreciates that paragraph 3 of draft Article 2 provides that this draft article is without prejudice to any broader definition provided by any international instrument, customary international law or national law.

Switzerland appreciates the specification that the obligations of States relate to the prevention and punishment of crimes against humanity, whether committed in time of war - in the context of an armed conflict -
