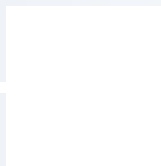
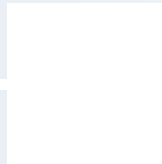
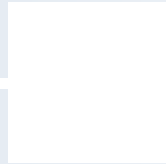
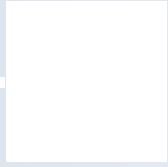
September 2001

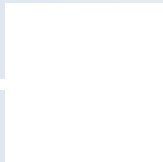

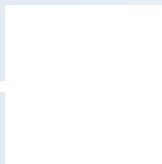
Resolution **215** addresses the role of transnational organized crime in supporting terrorism

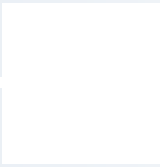
May 2015
